



TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

On this 13 day of July, 2015 came on to be considered the request by Danny Lee Davis, Veterans Service Officer., for a waiver of the prohibition of carrying a concealed weapon on the premises of any government court or offices utilized by the court, specifically the Hopkins County Courthouse and Annexes, Sulphur Springs, Texas. The Court makes the following findings:

1. Danny Lee Davis is the holder of a valid concealed handgun license, to wit, License 06567055;
2. Danny Lee Davis is a Veterans Service Officer in good standing of Hopkins County;
3. Danny Lee Davis has made a sufficient showing of the need for a waiver of the prohibition of carrying a concealed weapon on the premises of any government court or offices utilized by the court, as expressed in Texas Penal Code section 46.03(a)(3)

The Court makes the following conclusions:

1. Section 46.003(a)(3) of the Texas Penal Code provides for a waiver of the prohibition of carrying a concealed weapon on the premises of any government court or offices utilized by the court by written authorization of the court;
2. When issued, the above-referenced written authorization supersedes the prohibition of carrying a concealed weapon by a license holder as expressed in sections 46.03(a)(3) and 30.06 of the Texas Penal Code.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Danny Lee Davis is hereby authorized to carry a concealed handgun in any courthouse or office utilized by the court pursuant to the license issued to him/her by the Texas Department of Public Safety, so long as the license is in good standing.
