

WHEREAS, certain conditions exist which represent a threat to the public health and safety; and WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of Hopkins County to apply for funding under the Texas Community Development Block Grant Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF HOPKINS COUNTY, TEXAS:

- 1. That a Texas Community Development Block Grant Program application for The Disaster Relief Fund is hereby authorized to be filed on behalf of Hopkins County with the Texas Department of Agriculture.
- 2. That the County's application be placed in competition for funding under the Community Development Fund.
- 3. That the application be for <u>\$350,000.00</u> of grant funds to carry out road improvements and program administration.
- 4. That the Commissioners Court directs and designates the County Judge as the County's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and the County's participation in the Texas Community Development Block Grant Program.
- 5. That all funds will be used in accordance with all applicable federal, state, local and programmatic requirements including but not limited to procurement, environmental review, labor standards, real property acquisition and civil rights requirements.

This is to notify the Texas Department of Agriculture, Texas Community Development Block Grant (TxCDBG) Program that Hopkins County intends to proceed with its 2015 Disaster Relief Fund application project for damage to county roads per the pre-agreement cost stratagem. As a condition of the pre-agreement Hopkins County acknowledges and agrees to the following:

1.
