

## ORDER AUTHORIZING SAN JACINTO DAY FIREWORKS SALES

- WHEREAS, The Commissioners Court of <u>Hopkins</u> County is authorized under Occupations Code Section 2154.202(h)(2), to issue an order allowing retail fireworks permit holders to sell fireworks to the public in celebration of San Jacinto Day; and
- WHEREAS, On the <u>13<sup>th</sup></u> day of <u>February</u>, 2017, the Commissioners Court of <u>Hopkins</u> County has determined that conditions are favorable to issue such an Order; and

**NOW THEREFORE,** the Commissioners Court of <u>Hopkins</u> County adopts this Order authorizing the sale of fireworks to the public by retail fireworks permit holders during the San Jacinto Day period beginning April 16, 2017 and ending at midnight April 21, 2017, subject to the following restrictions:

a. This order expires on the date the Texas Fire Service determines drought conditions exist in the county or midnight, April 21, 2017, whichever is earlier.
