 RE: SB 546 and Advanced Designation Transcripts

Enclosed is a transcript of the classes that have been recorded for your SB 546 continuing education requirements.

As a reminder, elected officials are required to have 20 hours of education each year, 10 of those hours must be property tax-related if your county collects property tax. The Texas Association of Counties does not keep track of how many of your hours are property tax-related. It is up to you to keep track of this information.

If you or any of your staff have earned a Professional County Collector (PCC), County Tax Office Professional (CTOP), Professional County Assessor-Collector (PCAC) or Professional Deputy Assessor-Collector (PCAC), prior to calendar year 2017, a transcript for your continuing education maintenance has also been included.

Deputies who have a PCC, CTOP or PDAC need 10 hours of continuing education to maintain this certification. Elected Officials need 20 hours of continuing education to maintain this certification.

Carry-Over Hours: For elected officials, 10 hours can carry-over to the next year. Deputies can carry-over 5 hours.

TAC ID: Your transcript has your ID number at the upper right side. This is your unique identifier with the Texas Association of Counties. Please use this number when submitting education hours or requesting information.

Earning a PCC/CTOP/PCAC/PDAC: If you or any of your staff are working toward earning a PCC, CTOP, or PCAC/PDAC designation, an earnings transcript has also been enclosed.
