ORDER AUTHORIZING MEMORIAL DAY FIREWORKS SALES


**WHEREAS,** The Commissioners Court of Hopkins County is authorized under Occupations Code Section 2154.202(h)(3), to issue an order allowing retail fireworks permit holders to sell fireworks to the public in celebration of Memorial Day; and


**WHEREAS,** On the 22nd day of January, 2018, the Commissioners Court of Hopkins County has determined that conditions are favorable to issue such an Order; and


**NOW THEREFORE,** the Commissioners Court of Hopkins County adopts this Order authorizing the sale of fireworks to the public by retail fireworks permit holders during the Memorial Day period beginning May 23, 2018 and ending at midnight May 28, 2018, subject to the following restrictions:

- a. This order expires on the date the Texas Fire Service determines drought conditions exist in the county or midnight, May 28, 2018, whichever is earlier.




