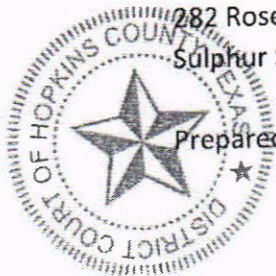



2019 Children/Youth Health & Wellness In-depth Youth Summary

Family & Community Health Extension Agent, Hopkins County

Relevance:

According to 2018 statistics, the total Hopkins County population is approximately 36,810, with 24.6% under the age of 18 (County Information Program, Texas Association of Counties.) Sulphur Springs, the county seat, has a population of approximately 16,135.

21.1% of children under the age of 17 live in poverty, while diabetes prevalence among the total population is 12% and obesity rate is 31.3% (<https://www.usnews.com/news/healthiest-communities/texas/hopkins-county>.) All schools in Hopkins County are eligible for free or reduced lunch. Hopkins County ranks 88 in the state (www.countyhealthrankings.org) for Health Outcomes, which include overall health, physical health, mental health, and low birthweight, an improvement from previous years. The county ranks 117 concerning Health Factors, which include smoking, obesity, physical inactivity, primary care physicians and dentist ratio to patients, diabetic monitoring, children in poverty, children in single-parent households, severe housing problems, and preventable hospital stays. This is also an improvement from previous years.

The Community Health/Wellness Alliance, Hopkins County Master Wellness Volunteers, and the Family & Community Health Committee have been driving forces in addressing issues pertaining to nutrition, physical activity, and well-being. These groups identified the need to continue addressing childhood health by implementing the multi-day "Kids' Camp: Fun, Food, Fitness" for students in grades 1 thru 4, which focuses on nutrition, physical activity, safety, and horticulture. 2019 was the 10th year for this popular camp.

Due to responses from parents whose children had aged-out of Kids' Camp, a camp for students in grades 5 & 6 was developed (Skills Camp) to provide learning experiences in a variety of workshops, thus keeping the kids off the couch and away from phones, computers, and video games. 2019 was the 5th year for this 4-session day camp.

Response:

The Alliance developed "Kids' Camp: Fun, Food, Fitness" as a way to address these topics, primarily childhood overweight & inactivity. By reaching the children, parents also receive valuable information through the "trickle-up" effect. The three-week summer camp takes place three days a week from 9:00 a.m. to noon. "Skills Camp" is a 4-session day camp. Topics for both camps are updated annually.

Collaborators included:

Community Health/Wellness Alliance, Master Wellness Volunteers, Master Gardeners, DSHS staff from Hopkins County, Rotary Club, Trinity Mother Frances System, Blue Blazes Drill Team, Better Living for Texans, Sulphur Springs Sheriff's Department, Classic Lanes, TxDOT, Pet Sense, Professional Photographer, Professional Chef, Community Action Network (CAN Help) and retired teachers.

The members of Texas A&M AgriLife will provide equal opportunities in programs and activities, education, and employment to all persons regardless of race, color, sex, religion, national origin, age, disability, genetic information, veteran status, sexual orientation or gender identity and will strive to achieve full and equal employment opportunity throughout Texas A&M AgriLife.

Registration for “Kids’ Camp” was limited to the first 40 participants, and for Skills Camp, the first 14 (due to the hands-on nature of the camp.) Registrations for both camps were distributed through the Sulphur Springs schools toward the end of the school year.

Results:

- *Demographics (Kids’ Camp):* 10 Hispanic; 3 Black; 25 White; 38 Blue Blaze Drill Team members; 6 Master Wellness Volunteers; 7 Master Gardeners; 15 adult presenters/volunteers. *Skills Camp:* 2 Hispanic, 2 Black, 8 White; 3 Master Wellness Volunteers daily; 5 session leaders
- *Grades (Kids’ Camp):* 1st grade, 11; 2nd grade, 10; 3rd grade, 7; 4th grade, 11. *Skills Camp:* 5th grade, 5; 6th grade, 7.
- *Kids’ Camp:* 9 sessions covering Nutrition/MyPlate and hands-on food preparation; Physical activity, Walk Across Texas, Yoga, team games; Gardening; sun, water, bike safety; bullying.
- *Skills Camp:* 4 sessions covering baking/food safety; pet care; photography; woodworking.

- Campers reported **804.65 miles** (16,093 minutes) in six days.
- Intent to adopt practices of eating breakfast every day, eating more fruits & veggies, and drink more water – 27 (95%); intent to use Kids’ camp recipes at home – 25 (89%)

Kids’ Camp participants were given a bag, t-shirt, booklet of all camp recipes, Friday snack packs, certificates for each food group, prizes for most miles logged, and incentive items (Better Living for Texans milk cups, drinking bottles, soup mugs, cool wraps, and MyPlate plates). On the final day, they were provided with unlimited bowling and free access to laser tag.

Skills Camp take-home items included: muffin pans, mini whisks, wooden spoon, measuring cup, handmade camera, hand-crafted wooden tote box with handle, yard stick, tape measure, tool apron.

Written evaluations from Skills Camp (12 returned):

- Campers indicating that they learned something new – 12 (100%)
- Favorite session – Baking (4); Photography (4); Pet Care/service dog (3); Woodworking (1)
- Future suggestions – Office/interview skills (7); Sewing (4); STEM (2); Public Speaking (2)
- Intent to adopt practices learned at camp – 12 (100%)

Future Implications: Dates are set for the 2020 Kids’ Camp and Skills Camp. We will use survey feedback to plan sessions and update topics. Both camps have been highly successful.

2019 4-H Hopkins County Agricultural Plan

*Developed by Dr. Mario A. Villarino, County Extension Agent for Agriculture and Natural Resources
Hopkins County, Texas*

Relevance: 4-H Agriculture and Natural Resources projects are an important component of the county 4-H program in Texas. Currently, sixty three percent of Texas 4-H members are enrolled in a livestock project. These projects provide youth with subject matter education, as well as valuable learning experiences, character education and leadership skills. Adult volunteer engagement is critical to administer the program and expand outreach. The development of youth volunteers as ambassadors for agriculture and natural resources will educate and recruit other youth to the project. Today youth are further removed from farming. Many do not understand the importance of agriculture and how it impacts their daily lives. This plan included a Science of Agriculture (Ag Literacy/Awareness) program component to target elementary students (grades 4) and teachers in Hopkins County and provides the following educational components: Educational support materials for Science of Agriculture including Ag Day/Ag Fair field trip and information about 4-H opportunities for the participants and parents. Water conservation/protection awareness will be also included. Hopkins County will utilize 4-H Livestock Project Coalitions to provide direction and support for the programs and events conducted. The programs and events provided support unities for 4-Hers to develop or improve their leadership skills and other life skills. Volunteer recruitment, training, and utilization will be an important component of the plan. This plan involved 200 youth and 60 volunteers in projects and 900 in curriculum enrichment component in Ag/NR 4-H projects.

Response: 12 Veterinary Science Sessions (Monthly) (12 participants), 2 State Heifer Validation, NETLA Steer Validation, 6 Coalition Meetings, NETLA Swine Validation (Nov), District Dairy Judging Contest (Jan), District Livestock Judging (April), HC 4-H Round Up (36 participants), NETLA project visits (36), NETLA Junior Livestock Show (Feb)(330 exhibitors), Ag in the Classroom (Oct)(900 youth, 80 adults), Goat Clipping Clinic (Feb) (4 youth),Goat and Lamb Showmanship Clinic (10 youth), Shot Gun District Competition (May) (110 youth), Poultry Clinic (Nov) (25 youth), NETLA Dairy Show (June) (12 youth).

Results: A specific path to the plate post test was conducted in a statistically significant subsample (64 students) in a randomly selected 4th grade school class in Hopkins County, with test results as follows:

- 63% (40/64) indicated a better understanding of the connection between agriculture and health.
- 84% (53/63) have a better understanding of the path food takes to get to their plate.
- 63% (40/64) have a better understanding of the importance and nutritional values of food
- 77% (49/64) have a better understanding of the way farmers and ranchers produce the food they eat.
- 61% (39/64) have a better understanding of the value of agriculture and how it is important in life.
- 83% (52/63) have a better understanding of the importance of eating a healthy diet and a variety of food.

Impact: Agriculture and Natural Resource Projects in Texas remained a cornerstone for youth programs in 4-H. Hopkins County is no exception. More than 50 livestock projects and numerous public speaking and educational presentations were based on agriculture and natural resources. The Hopkins County Extension Office would like to recognize the multiple organizations supporting curriculum enrichment experiences and Hopkins Rains Farm Bureau for their support, leadership and commitment to our youth in Hopkins County during the 2018 Ag in the Classroom.
