

RESOLUTION


WHEREAS, The Hopkins County Commissioners Court finds that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Hopkins County, that a unified structure be created to provide services for its people regarding health, environmental services, and emergency services for those citizens; and

WHEREAS, The Hopkins County Commissioners Court proposes that The Local Health Authority, The Department of Environmental Services, The Department of Emergency Management, the Fire Marshals and the Designated Representative/Inspector be joined together as subdivisions under the direction of the Hopkins County Fire Department to form the Department of Homeland Security for Hopkins County, Texas; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Hopkins County Commissioners Court approves the creation of the Department of Homeland Security for Hopkins County.


