- I. "A Fresh Start to a Healthier You" seven participants in the February on-line course
- II. "Do Well, Be Well with Diabetes" 7 Hopkins County participants for on-line series in partnership with Hopkins, Fannin, Titus, and Rockwall Counties (one California resident registered under Hopkins County) – 20 participants in all
- III. District 4-H Food Challenge Hopkins County served as host county 38 teams from the East Texas region participated
- IV. District 4-H Roundup, Farmersville 3 Hopkins County youth participated: Rylie Carroll, Senior, received 1<sup>st</sup> place in Fashion Review, 1<sup>st</sup> place in Food Show, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place in Public Speaking. She will advance to State Roundup in June. Diego Childs, Intermediate, received 1<sup>st</sup> place in Poetry/Prose, and 7<sup>th</sup> place in Food Show Main Dish. Blaine Allen, Intermediate, placed 3<sup>rd</sup> in Food Show Side Dish.
- V. Adult Sewing Workshop: 5 participated in the 3-day workshop in late March. Four of the five were beginning sewers.
