- I. "A Fresh Start to a Healthier You" seven participants in the February on-line course
- II. "Do Well, Be Well with Diabetes" 7 Hopkins County participants for on-line series in partnership with Hopkins, Fannin, Titus, and Rockwall Counties (one California resident registered under Hopkins County) – 20 participants in all
- III. District 4-H Food Challenge Hopkins County served as host county 38 teams from the East Texas region participated
- IV. District 4-H Roundup, Farmersville 3 Hopkins County youth participated: Rylie Carroll, Senior, received 1st place in Fashion Review, 1st place in Food Show, and 3rd place in Public Speaking. She will advance to State Roundup in June. Diego Childs, Intermediate, received 1st place in Poetry/Prose, and 7th place in Food Show Main Dish. Blaine Allen, Intermediate, placed 3rd in Food Show Side Dish.
- V. Adult Sewing Workshop: 5 participated in the 3-day workshop in late March. Four of the five were beginning sewers.
