WHEREAS, in order to identify qualified and responsive providers for these services a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) process for Architect/engineering services has been completed in accordance with SLFRF requirements; Treasury CRF 200

WHEREAS, the proposals received by the due date have been reviewed to determine the most qualified and responsive providers for each professional service giving consideration to ability to perform successfully under the terms and conditions of the proposed procurement, integrity, compliance with public policy, record of past performance, and financial and technical resources

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

Section 1. That DRG be selected to provide application and project-related professional architect and/or engineering services for the SLFRF requirements; Treasury CRF 200

Section 2. That any and all project-related services contracts or commitments made with the above- named service provider are dependent SLFRF and successful negotiation of a contract with the service provider.
