
WHEREAS, On the 18th day of January, 2022, the Commissioners Court of Hopkins County has determined that conditions are favorable to issue such an Order; and

NOW THEREFORE, the Commissioners Court of Hopkins County adopts this Order authorizing the sale of fireworks to the public by retail fireworks permit holders during the Texas Independence Day period beginning February 25, 2022 and ending at midnight on March 2, 2022, subject to the following restrictions:

- a. This order expires on the date the Texas Fire Service determines drought conditions exist in the county or midnight, March 2, 2022, whichever is earlier.





ORDER AUTHORIZING SAN JACINTO DAY FIREWORKS SALES




WHEREAS, On the 18th day of January, 2022, the Commissioners Court of Hopkins County has determined that conditions are favorable to issue such an Order; and

- a. This order expires on the date the Texas Fire Service determines drought conditions exist in the county or midnight, May 30, 2022, whichever is earlier.


