The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2024 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for County of Hopkins from the same properties in both the 2023 tax year and the 2024 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that County of Hopkins may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that County of Hopkins is proposing to increase property taxes for the 2024 tax year.

A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON August 26, 2024 AT 9:00 AM AT Commissioners Courtroom Hopkins County Courthouse 118 Church St, Sulphur Springs, TX.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, County of Hopkins is not required to hold an election at which voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the Hopkins County Commissioner's Court of County of Hopkins at their offices or by attending the public hearing mentioned above.
